Shopping at the Alternative Gifts at Christmas Market means your gifts will make an important difference in meeting needs around the world. **One purchase gives two gifts:** one to meet a need of a person or family or group of people you do not even know; the other to honor your family, friend, colleague or neighbor.

What Do I Need to Do?

- 1) **Come** to the Market on **December 2 or 9**, or **order by mail**.
- 2) If you come to the Market, visit the displays to “see” what you are purchasing or just sit down with the catalog and read about each gift.
- 3) Select the items that are appropriate for each person on your Christmas list. Fill out the attached **Shopping List**. Be sure to fill the list out **thoroughly**, including your check number if you are paying by check. This helps our accounting.
- 4) We need to keep the Shopping List for accounting purposes, so if you would like a record of your purchases, please list your gifts and recipients on the Calligraphy/Keeping a Record form, which is the last page of this packet.
- 5) Fill out the Payment Form completely. Please note the handling fee is \$2 for orders \$20 or less and \$5 for orders over \$20. The handling fee covers printing and other expenses, enabling all gift money to go directly to recipient organizations.
- 6) Regular cards are \$1 each; cards with a painting of the NPC sanctuary are \$3. If you want calligraphy done, please fill out the Calligraphy/Keeping a Record form. Calligraphy is available at the Market; it is not available by mail.
- 7) Before you get in line for the cashier, be sure you have your Shopping List, Payment Form and Calligraphy Form completed.
- 8) Pay by cash or check at the cashier station. You will receive your cards and inserts (the paragraphs from the catalog describing the gifts). If you are requesting calligraphy, please take your Calligraphy Form to the calligraphy table.
- 9) If you are **ordering by mail**, complete the Shopping List and Payment Form, including the number of gift cards. Please send these forms and a check for the total purchase amount to:
